M. Coyle will lead the Green Space project by reviewing survey results and compiling info for a second, deeper quiz of the community, before recommending to the board how to proceed. R. Brueggemann will lead the Orange Strip project by working with the City to understand what can be built under current zoning and what the City means by medium intensity. Based on these findings and the survey results Brueggemann will make recommendations to the board. Potential recommendations include seeking removal of the orange strip by City Commission via the planning documents, approaching Houslers with the City to develop a mutually acceptable development, or to oppose any changes/development. J. Carroll will lead Streets and Sidewalks by reviewing survey results and working with the City on the most popular complaints regarding streets and sidewalks.
